SUBJECT: MOCREEBEC

WHEREAS the MoCreebec people are indigenous to James Bay and are recognized as aboriginal people;

WHEREAS the MoCreebec people have a special status and relationship to the Federal Government of Canada;

WHEREAS the MoCreebec people are seeking to be established and recognized in the Moosonee/Moose Factory area of James Bay;

WHEREAS the MoCreebec delegation have made representation to the Muskegog Cree Council Assembly on March 24, 1986;

WHEREAS the Treaty #9 component and application to MoCreebec needs further clarification;

WHEREAS the land base, Band status and community aspiration of MoCreebec will require additional resources which will not diminish present resources to Bands in the James Bay area;
